



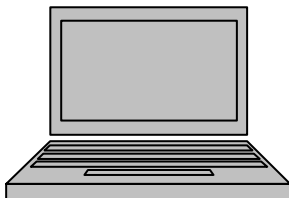

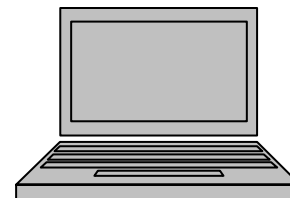

To connect you need:

A laptop with integrated WI-FI capability

Or

A laptop with WI-Fi compliant 802.11b/g wireless device

And

Microsoft Internet Explorer, Netscape Navigator or any other Web Browser installed on your laptop.

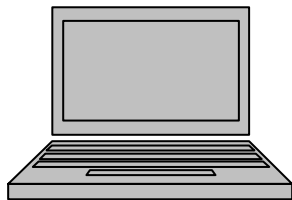
Mac Instructions

Using Macintosh Mac OS 9

1. Go to the Apple Menu, select "Airport"
2. Turn Airport "On"
3. At the Apple Menu, select "Control Panels" and "TCP/IP"
4. Select "Connect Via" and choose "Airport from the drop down menu
5. IN the Configure Menu, select "Using DHCP Server"
6. Close the window and when prompted save changes
7. Launch your Web browser and start surfing!

Using Macintosh Mac OS X

1. Go the Apple Menu, select "System Preferences"
2. Select "Network" and verify that "Show" is set to "Airport"
3. Select the "TCP/IP" tab
4. The settings should appear as follows: Configure: Using DHCP (leave all else blank)
5. Launch your Web browser and start surfing!



Windows OS Instructions

Using Windows 2000 and XP

1. Click on "start"
2. Go to "Settings" then Control Panel"
3. Double-click on "Network and Dial-up Connections" or "Network Connections"
4. Right-click on "Local Area Connections" then click on "Properties"
5. In "Components Checked are being used by this connection", select "Internet Protocol (TCP/IP)"
6. Click on "Properties" and select "Obtain an IP address automatically"
7. Click on "OK" twice
