

WHEREAS the Albert Wisner Library located at 2 Colonial Avenue in the Village of Warwick, New York has served the community since May of 1927 when the population of the community was 2,200; and

WHEREAS the community has reached a population of 22,000 and the library needs of the community cannot be served properly in the current space of the building; and

WHEREAS the Albert Wisner Library building is not equipped efficiently to serve the handicapped and senior residents of the community; and

WHEREAS the Albert Wisner Library cannot provide sufficient resources to the teen population of the community due to space constraints; and

WHEREAS the Albert Wisner Library cannot provide appropriate space for parent and children services due to space constraints; and

WHEREAS the Albert Wisner Library cannot provide adequate reading and research selections for the community due to space constraints; and

WHEREAS the Albert Wisner Library cannot provide up to date technology for its patrons due to space constraints; and

WHEREAS the Albert Wisner Library can only provide minimal parking spaces for its patrons; and

WHEREAS the Albert Wisner Library Building has outgrown its 80 year-old space and is in need of a larger building designed to meet the needs of a growing community; therefore be it

RESOLVED that this Village Board of Trustees supports the referendum for an \$8.5 million bond for the construction of a new library building which will sufficiently serve the needs of the Warwick community.
