May 8 at 6:30-7:30: Little Bits & Ozobots – Experiment with coding concepts.

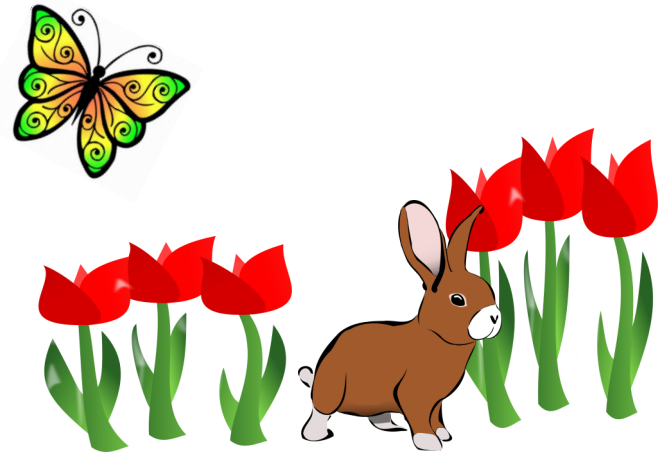
May 22 at 5:30-7:00: Calligraphy with Ron Gee – Come learn calligraphy basics from local artist Ron Gee.
