Albert Wisner Public Library Environmental Safety Practices Policy

In order to provide a safe and welcoming environment for everyone, Albert Wisner Public Library (AWPL) has adopted this *Environmental Safety Practices Policy* as an addendum to its existing *Behavior Policy*.

All AWPL staff members have the authority to enforce these measures. Concerns should be brought to the attention of Library Director Lisa Laico at llaico@rcls.org or 845-968-1047, ext. 6.

Safety Practices:

- 1. Masks are recommended for all unvaccinated people, and optional for all others as of 3/2/2022.
- 2. Social distancing is encouraged wherever possible.
- 3. No person should enter the Library building if they have a fever, feel ill or are in contact with someone who is unwell with a communicable/contagious illness.
- 4. Hand sanitizer will be available upon entering the building.
- 5. At the discretion of the Library Director, the following services may be limited or restricted:
 - Hours of operation
 - Building and room occupancy
 - Length of visit
 - Access to public computers and other Library equipment
 - Access to photocopier and faxing services
 - Access to collections
 - Availability of meeting rooms and specific Library spaces
 - Seating
 - Access to public restrooms
 - In-person meetings and programs

ADA Compliance:

If compliance with any safety requirement is not possible on the basis of a disability, please contact the Library Director to explore reasonable accommodation.

Failure to Comply:

Any person not abiding by any aspect of this policy may be asked to leave the Library.
