



## *Featured Artist...Renelle Lorry*

Renelle Lorry is a Warwick photographer specializing in capturing the beauty of the area and the details within. Her photography journey began in the early 1970s and she is self-taught, except for darkroom work. In 2007, she transitioned to digital and acquired a laptop and inkjet printer.

Renelle is a member of the Warwick, Goshen and Ringwood, NJ Art Leagues, Sussex, NJ and Orange County Arts Councils, and the Wallkill River School. She exhibits regularly at these venues and has won many awards in juried shows. Since 2015, she has been the key photographer for Pumpkinfest on behalf of the Pine Island Chamber of Commerce. She also curated two exhibits at the Albert Wisner Library for the Goshen Art League and for watercolorist Marcy Talbot.

Renelle's images appeared on the cover of the WVT phone directory cover three times since 2012 and placed 2<sup>nd</sup> in 2020. Several images are in the 2017 Warwick Sesquicentennial Commemorative Book. The Jolly Onion restaurant in Pine Island has been graciously hosting her work since early last year, and new work is usually hung every 6 to 8 weeks. Notecards featuring more than 100 images are available at Bertoni Gallery in downtown Warwick.

The photos in this online exhibit are some favorite winter scenes from Renelle's sizable collection. Her other subjects include local farms, parks, flora, fauna, and reflections. Renelle's eye for detail has allowed her to capture unique images within overall landscapes, and she is ever watchful for those once-in-a-lifetime shots.
